

A pay rise and fairer taxes for hard working people

Hard work should be matched by fair pay and taxes helping people stand on their own two feet. Labour will raise the minimum wage to at least £8 an hour, incentivise the living wage, and ban damaging zero-hour contracts. Labour will cut taxes for 24 million working people through a new lower starting rate of tax. We will reverse the Tory tax cut for millionaires, scrap the bedroom tax, and take tough action against tax dodgers.



Real action to help with the cost of living crisis

Under the Tories, Wales has the highest energy bills in Britain, hitting pensioners and families hard. Average energy bills have rocketed by £300. Labour will freeze gas and electricity bills until 2017 and shake up the energy companies. Childcare costs are too high for many. We will double early years and childcare provision for working parents of 3 and 4 year olds, which means an extra 10 hours of free childcare.



Jobs and training for our young people

Welsh Labour has already helped 16,000 young people in Wales find opportunities through the Jobs Growth Wales scheme. We will build on this, guaranteeing a job or training for 18-24 year olds out of work for a year or more. We will stop wages for young jobseekers being undercut by banning agencies that only

hire workers from overseas. Locally, Stephen will continue to fight to protect services and community facilities for young people and children.



Protecting and investing in our NHS

A strong and improved NHS is vital for our young and old. The Tories and UKIP want to privatise and breakup our NHS. Labour will continue to invest in the future of our Welsh NHS and support our hard working staff, by training 1,000 extra doctors, nurses and healthcare

professionals funded by a clamp down on tax avoidance, a levy on tobacco firms and a Mansion Tax on properties worth over £2 million.
